

CGS VIRTUAL ARCHIVES

There are rich but rarely used resources in Canada of files containing historical information on geotechnical laboratory and field research, geotechnical investigations, work of committees, and geotechnical expertise. Ways to identify and use these resources have been developed by the Heritage Committee of the Canadian Geotechnical Society in the form of virtual archives on the CGS web pages, where the location and content of accessible historical geotechnical material are given.

CGS members, and others, are invited to submit candidate projects for consideration. The submission should give the location of the material, a description of its nature and content, its historical significance and conditions under which it can be accessed. Do not submit physical archival material as the Society has no space in which to store it. However, electronic copies of photographs or drawings are welcomed.
