The application package should include the following as the minimum:

- 1) Completed application form (Max 1 page)
- 2) A signed statement of support from the research supervisor endorsing the application (Max 2 pages)
- 3) A 500-word synopsis of the nominee's research project describing the purpose and relevance of the expected or actual outcome, and how it is expected to improve the current state of practice in geotechnique
- 4) Academic transcript (Note that the nominee should have completed all the course requirements for the nominee's Master's program)
- 5) Resume (Max 2 pages)

For award ceremony purposes, the nomination package should also include a digital image (300 dpi) of the nominee in the jpeg format.

Notes:

- This prize is offered to a full-time post-graduate student at a Master's level, attending a Canadian university whose research focus is directly related to the field of geotechnique.
- The award is granted primarily based on academic excellence, the purpose and relevance of the research project to the practice of geotechnique, and the quality of the research summary.
- Students who have displayed activity in volunteering or leadership roles in geotechnique will receive special consideration.
- Nominees must either be currently in their Master's program or have graduated from a Master's program within the past 12 months.
- Nominations are limited to one per academic department.
- Nominations can be made in English or French.
